Preliminary Remarks & Swearing in of New Members

The meeting of the Judicial Council of Georgia (Council) was called to order at 2:00 p.m. by Chief Justice Melton. Chief Justice Melton administered the Council oath to two new members to the Council: Judge Arthur Smith of the Chattahoochee Circuit was sworn in his capacity as the President-Elect of the Council of Superior Court Judges, and Judge Shawn Rhodes of Wilcox County was sworn in his capacity as the President-Elect of the Council of Probate Court Judges.

Chief Justice Melton also recognized Judge Wade Padgett as the new President of the Council of Superior Court Judges, Judge Thomas Lakes as the new President of the Council of Probate Court Judges, and Judge Quinn Kasper as the new President of the Council of Magistrate Court Judges.

Roll Call of Judicial Council Members

Ms. Mason called roll for Council members; staff and guests were instructed to submit their attendance for the purpose of the minutes.

Discussion of Statewide Judicial Emergency Orders and COVID-19 Update by Judicial Council Members

Chief Justice Melton opened with a discussion on the Fourteenth Order Extending Declaration of Judicial Emergency (Order), scheduled to go out May 8th. Chief Justice Melton explained that this Order has been streamlined to the reflect the current status of court operations and recognized the efforts of Presiding Justice Nahmias on restructuring the Order. Chief Justice Melton clarified that provisions of previous orders still need to be considered and reported that the Order lifts the suspension of the two provisions that govern the 90-day grand jury process and 120day jury process for juvenile courts, effective May 14th. Chief Justice Melton also reiterated that when Governor Kemp no longer renews the statewide Public Health Emergency, the Judicial Public Health Emergency authority will end as well. Along those lines, Chief Justice Melton pointed toward the passage of Senate Bill 163, which will soon be signed by the Governor. Senate Bill 163 will give greater flexibility for statutory speedy trial requirements, allowing circuits to issue orders suspending those requirements at the local level; draft model orders are being worked on to assist courts. House Bill 635 also passed and will be signed by the Governor as well. Chief Justice Melton asked courts to continue to favor remote proceedings where possible, and to reach out if they encounter areas that may require future court rule or legislative changes. He also reminded local courts to review the Judicial Emergency Act prior to issuing any local orders. Presiding Justice Nahmias encouraged the Council to begin thinking about how best to proceed when the statewide Public Health Emergency ends and other deadlines begin to be implemented again.
